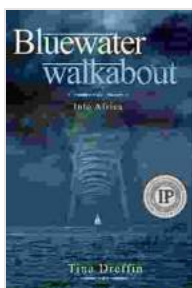


Bluewater Walkabout Into Africa: Tina Dreffin's Epic Journey

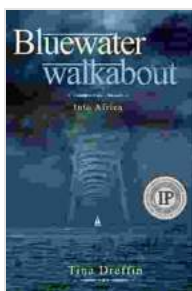

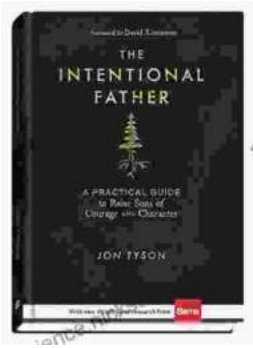
