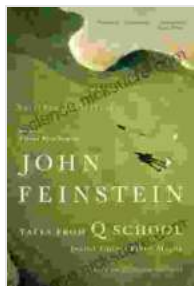

Oahu, Hawaii. The tournament moved to the Plantation Course at Kapalua Resort in 1999.

Format of the Tournament of Champions

The TOC is a 72-hole, stroke-play tournament. The tournament field is limited to 30 players. The winner of the TOC receives the "Champion Golfer of the Year" trophy. The TOC is the first of the four major championships on the PGA Tour schedule.

To qualify for the TOC, a player must win a PGA Tour event during the previous calendar year. The top 30 players in the OWGR are also eligible to play in the TOC.

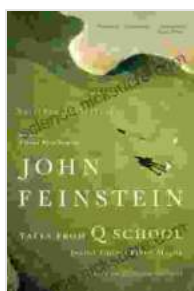
The Plantation Course at Kapalua Resort

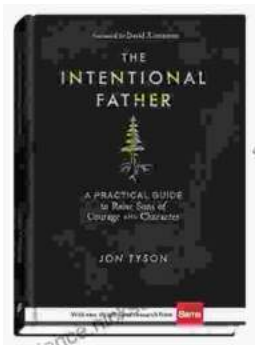
