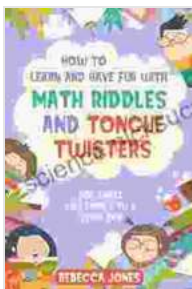

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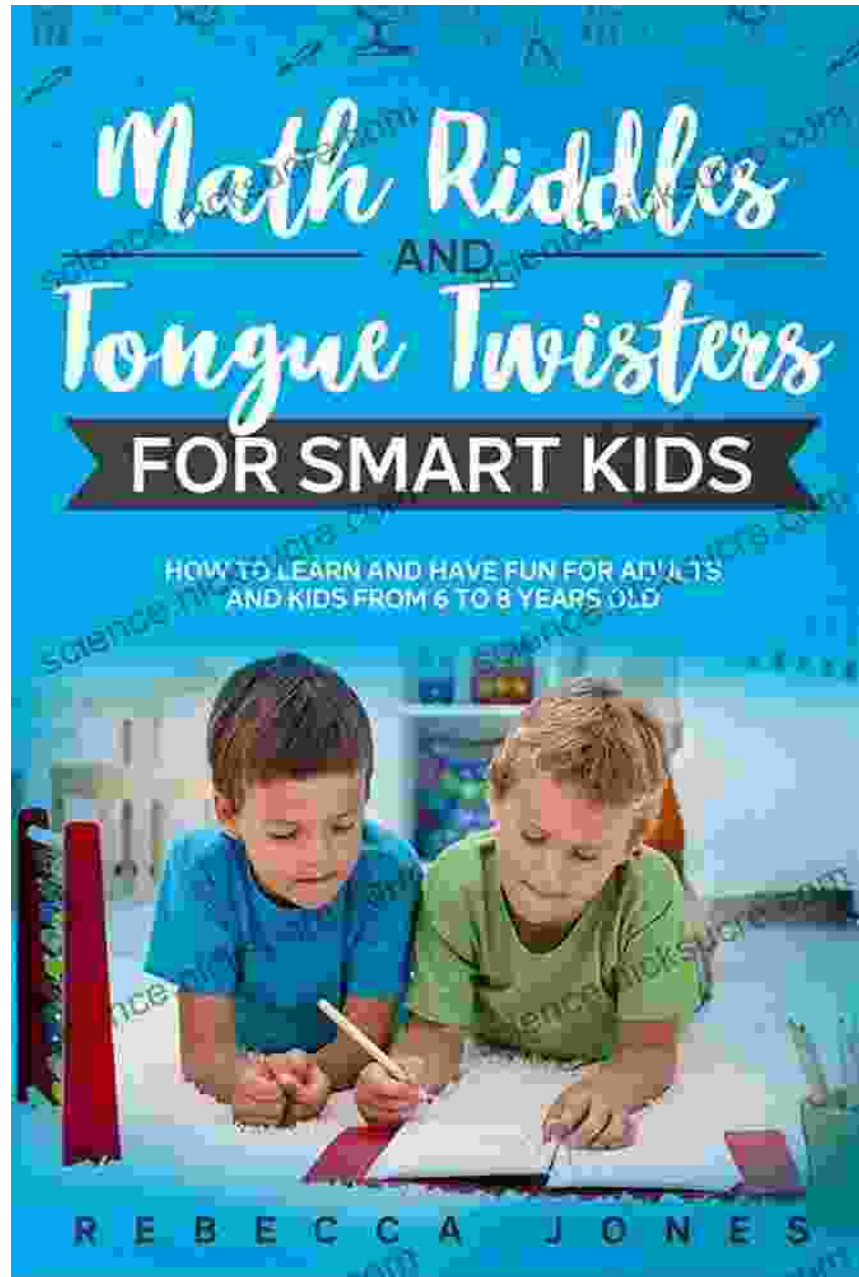

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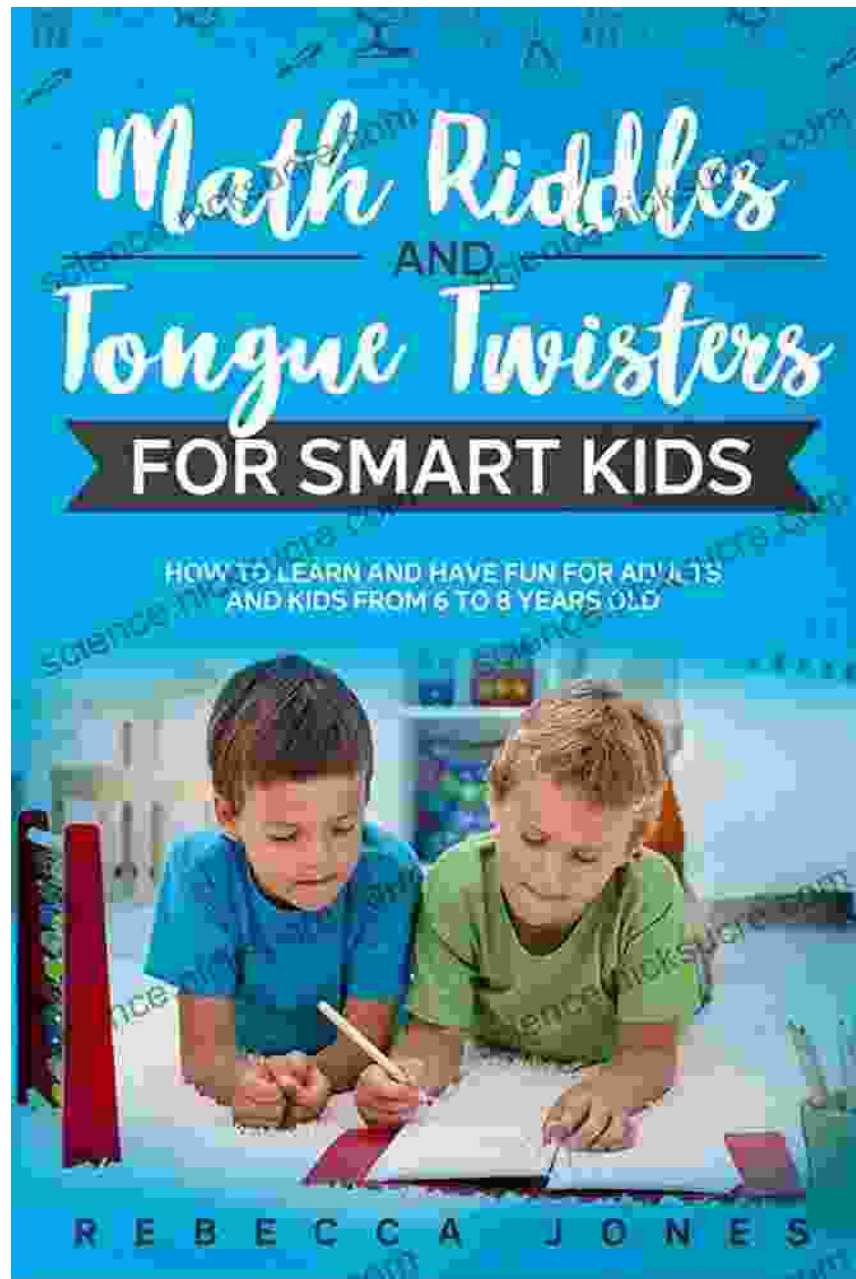

1. Two fathers and two sons are fishing on a boat. Yet there are only three people in the boat. How is that possible?



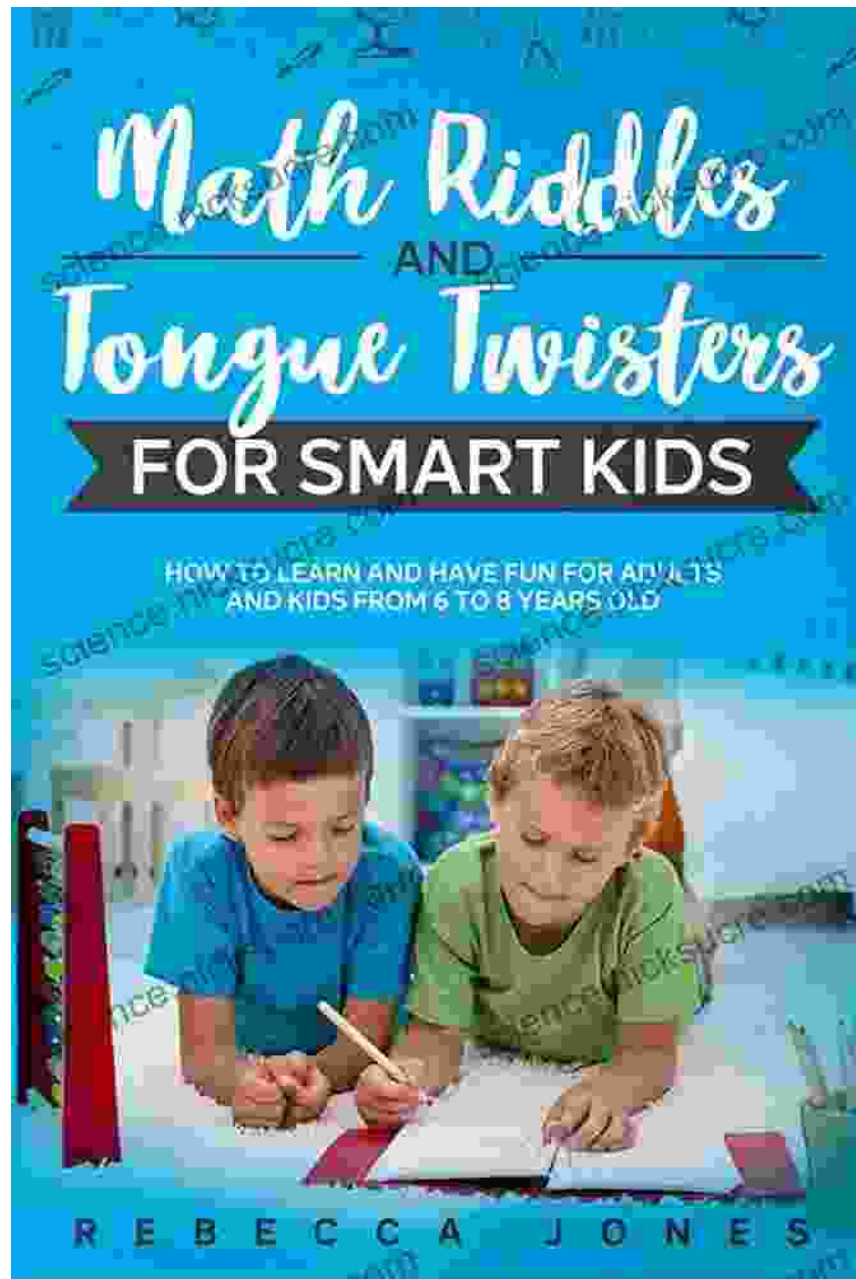
Answer: They are grandfather, father, and son

4. I have keys but no locks. I have a space but no room. You can enter but can't go outside. What am I?



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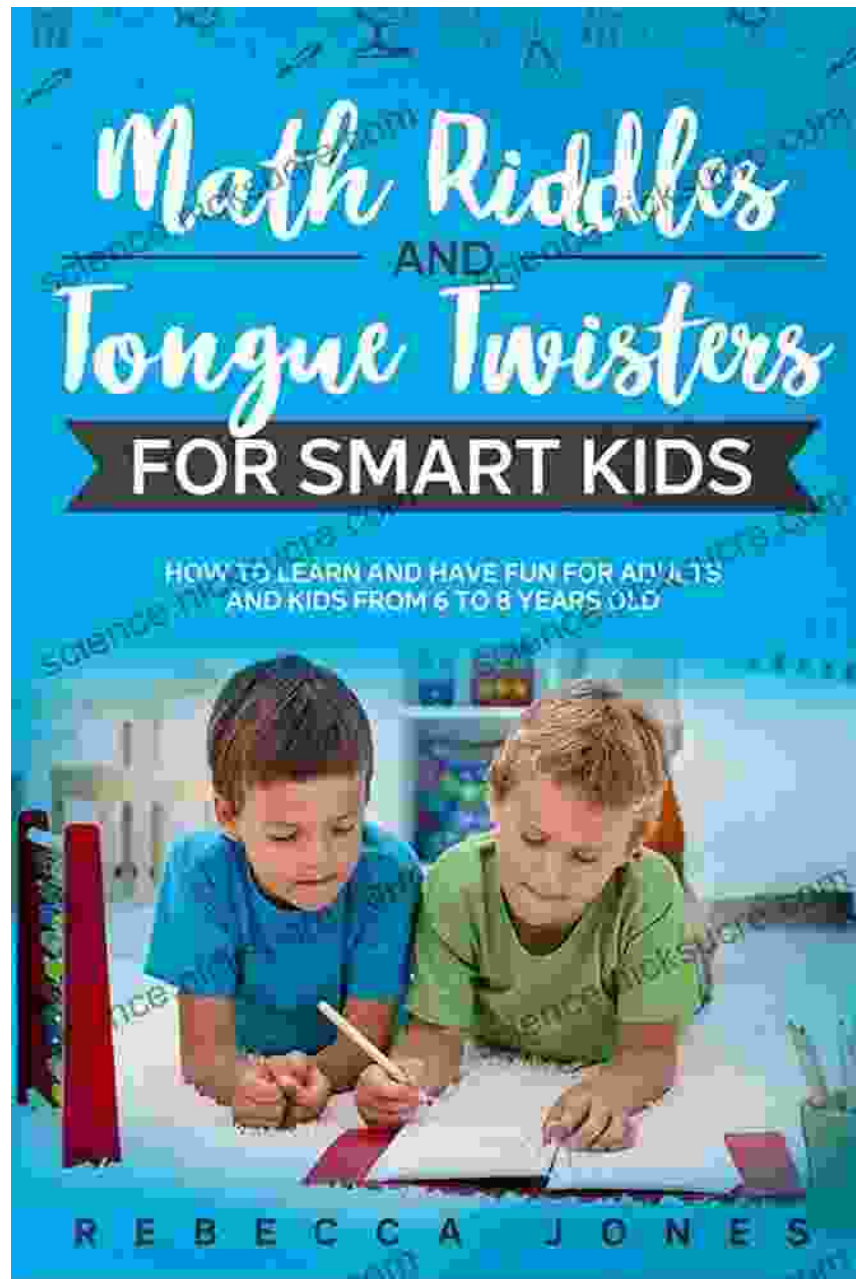
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Answer: A keyboard

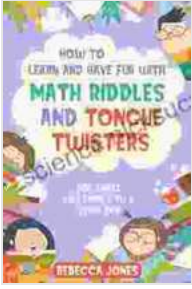

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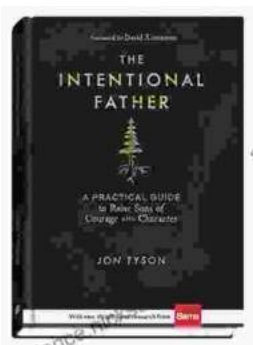
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
